

This document shows you how to replace your current antivirus program with Microsoft Security Essentials Antivirus and Mal-ware protection.

Turn on your computer and make sure you are connected to the internet.

In the address bar of your Internet Web Browser, type: www.efoxfamily.com

- Click the "Computer Cleaning And Optimization" link.
- Scroll down to the "Antivirus Removal Tools" section and locate the proper removal tool for your antivirus program. Click on it to download to your computer. Locate the file on your computer and double click the file to launch and remove your antivirus.

Shut down and restart your computer if it hasn't done so already.

Restart your computer and make sure you are connected to the internet.

In the address bar of your Internet Web Browser, type: www.efoxfamily.com

- Click the "Computer Cleaning And Optimization" link.
- Click on the link named "Microsoft Security Essentials".
- Once you are at Microsoft's web site, click once the large blue "Download Now" button in the middle of the screen to download Microsoft Security Essentials. Click the link of the operating system that you have*. Download and save the file.
- Locate the file on your computer and double click the file to launch and install Microsoft Security Essentials. Follow all on-screen prompts.

* If you are not sure what operating system you have (32-bit or 64-bit), refer to the documentation that came with the computer.

***** Warnings, Recommendations & User Agreement *****


* If you experience problems operating your PC, Windows or programs, shut down your computer and restart. Do not unplug or turn off computer while programs, downloads or hard drive are running. Use the "Shut Down" option through your start button, or press "CTRL ALT DEL" on your keyboard at the same time and select "Shutdown" at top of window. If you are still unable to shut down your computer, hold down the power button for 5 seconds or until your computer shuts off. Be forewarned that you are doing this at your own risk and damage may occur by improperly shutting off your computer in this way.

* Leaving your computer on at all times is NOT recommended! Please use "Shut Down" to safely shut down your computer after every use. This allows your microprocessor and power supply to cool down, updates your registry if needed, allows Windows Update and other updated programs to install, configure and perform correctly.

* It is your sole responsibility to monitor the status of Microsoft Security Essentials upon every start up (MUST BE GREEN AT ALL TIMES!), and run the 2-step PC Maintenance ONCE weekly. I cannot be held responsible for damage done to your computer due to your negligence and by not following all of the steps as outlined within.

Microsoft Security Essentials - Free Antivirus & Malware Protection

The icon for it is located next to your clock on the taskbar. It looks like a house with a flag on the top of it. The program updates automatically with an active internet connection every time you turn your computer on. Once every Sunday morning at 3am (or when your computer is idle on this day or after) it will perform a scheduled scan of your computer automatically. This may slow PC performance dramatically, by 50%. This is normal. The icon should be GREEN at all times.  If it turns red or orange at any time, click on the icon and select "Open". Click "Upgrade", "Update" or "Scan Now" depending on the screen shown and choose to "Accept" the license agreement if any. The program will start the upgrade, update or scan automatically to bring the program and your computer up to date and protected. If you perform an update, upgrade or scan and the icon is still red or orange, then you must go through the same steps once again until it turns green. In other words, you may have several updates at once. Click "Finish" or the red "X" in the upper right hand corner when it is finished and the window will close and continue to keep your computer protected. DO NOT EXIT THE PROGRAM FROM YOUR TASKBAR. YOU WILL BE UNPROTECTED! If you ignore the status of this program, your PC will be unprotected and prone to malicious viruses and or malware attacks.

DO NOT INSTALL ANOTHER ANTIVIRUS PROGRAM SUCH AS NORTON ANTIVIRUS OR MCAFEE ANTIVIRUS. DOING SO MAY CAUSE CONFLICTS WITH YOUR PC AND CAUSE IT TO CRASH UNEXPECTEDLY!

DO NOT USE SYSTEM RESTORE OR PERFORM A RESTORATION OF YOUR HARD DRIVE AFTER YOU HAVE INSTALLED THESE PROGRAMS. DOING SO WILL CAUSE THE PROGRAM NOT TO FUNCTION PROPERLY OR AT ALL.
